Shooting Stars is an initiative of Netball WA (NWA) and Glass Jar Australia (GJA), which uses netball and other engagement strategies as vehicles to encourage greater engagement and attendance at school of young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander girls living in WA's remote communities and regional towns.

The program works collaboratively with the local community, schools and service providers to implement a regular program of personal development activity and fun for young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander girls. Participation in the program enables girls to have a taste of success to improve their self-image, develop hope and aspirations about their future, and provide motivation to attend school to achieve those aspirations.

A strong sense of purpose means that we understand the significant and meaningful role that we play in the lives of our participants, colleagues and community. As a Program Coordinator you will be responsible for the development, coordination and delivery of the Shooting Stars program at the local District High School with the primary aim of increasing overall participation in netball and school attendance of female Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.

**What will you be doing...**

- Responsibility for the ongoing delivery, monitoring and coordination of the Shooting Stars program in the local area.
- Working collaboratively with our Community Development Coordinator to assist in the delivery of community development programs within the wider community
- Build capacity and sustainability of the program through the identification of new community engagement initiatives with community stakeholders/commercial partners
- Work with the GJA and NWA team to grow the brand in a dynamic and vibrant way through identified community engagement initiatives, stakeholders, partners and channel
- Identify post school pathway opportunities for Shooting Stars participants in the local community

**What motivates you...**

We are looking for people who are passionate about advancing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander participation in school and sport through the provision of services to rural and remote communities. This is a hands on role that will work collaboratively with the school principal and we need people with an appreciation of Western Australia's Aboriginal communities. To be successful in this role you will need initiative, excellent interpersonal and networking skills along with a willingness to work in the field and engage with local communities.

**What will we give you in return...**

Working with the Shooting Stars Program will give you the opportunity to make a difference at the same time as building on your skills through training and support from the Shooting Stars team.
